Creatives Connect Afrika provides a strategic platform where creatives, investors, industry leaders, and policymakers converge to identify barriers, propose solutions, and catalyse partnerships that help unlock the full economic potential of Africa's cultural and creative value chains.



The African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA) Secretariat is a continental institution established in August 2020 to administer and implement the AfCFTA Agreement, the African Union's flagship initiative for deepening economic integration, that creates a single African market for goods and services, supported by free movement of businesspersons, capital and investment. The Secretariat drives policies, negotiations, and frameworks that remove barriers to intra-African trade, harmonise regulations, and create opportunities for businesses and creatives to scale across the continent.
